


Reliability Standards Tracking Site — How to Register

- (3) You must submit the RBB registration form (available in [Regional Reliability Standards](#) on ERCOT.com) to the Reliability Standards Manager. If your company is an ERCOT member, you must enter your company's market segment.


The Regional Standards Manager will review each registration. You will be notified if your registration has been accepted. Thank you for participating in the regional reliability standards process.

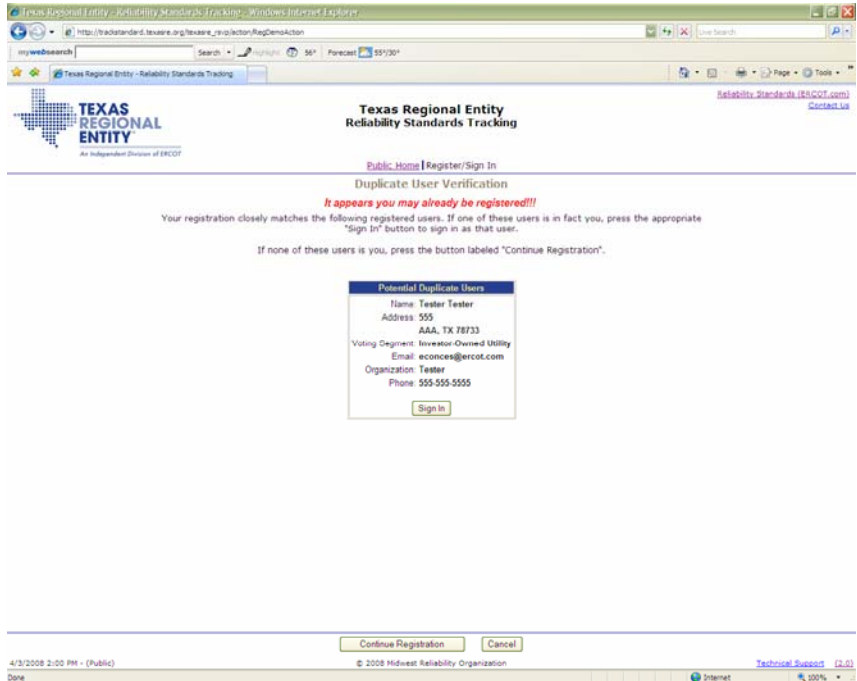

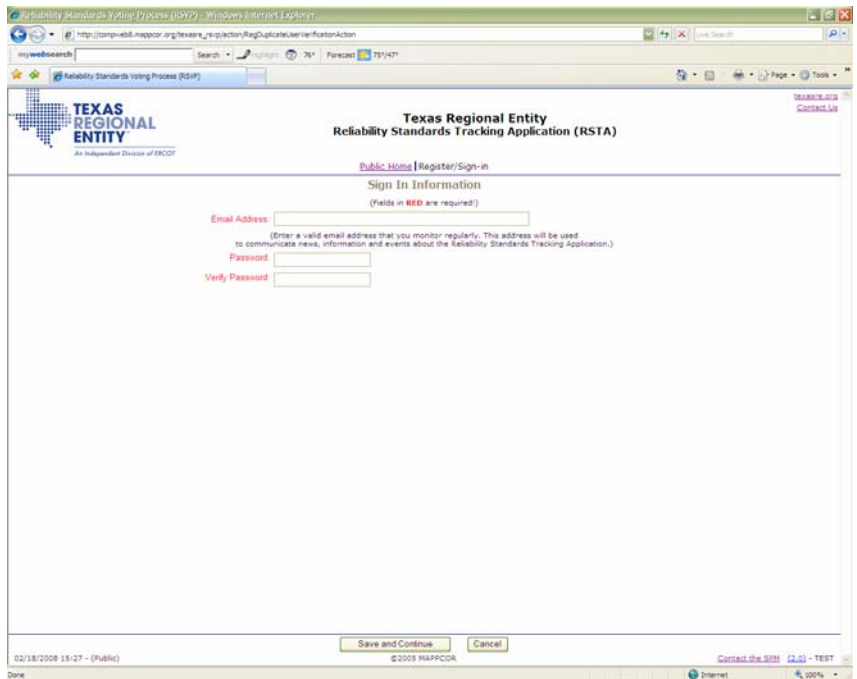

If this is not you, click “Continue Registration.”




Enter your contact e-mail address and a password.

At this time, make any necessary changes to your information by clicking "Edit."


When you are sure that all information is correct, click "Submit Registration."
