Texas RE is one of six Regional Entities in North America, which together with the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC), constitute the Electric Reliability Organization (ERO) Enterprise.



Texas RE provides a robust program to oversee and ensure reliability of the ERCOT Interconnection, which covers approximately 75% of Texas' land area and 90% of its electricity load.



## To accomplish our work Texas RE:

-  Manages a comprehensive registration program that tracks all users, owners, and operators of the bulk power system.
-  Conducts wide-ranging evaluations of compliance with NERC Reliability Standards.
-  Performs thorough event analyses and assesses emerging risks to the grid.
-  Evaluates proposed continental standards' impact on reliability in the ERCOT Interconnection.
-  Evaluates mitigation plans for entities that have failed to meet reliability standards to minimize future risk to the grid.

Texas RE provides frequent outreach in the form of webinars, workshops, newsletters, and announcements, all free of charge to entities to help them stay up to date on reliability rules and issues.
