

GridEx is a biennial grid security exercise hosted by the E-ISAC to provide E-ISAC member and partner organizations the opportunity to practice response and recovery from coordinated cyber and physical security threats and incidents.

The first GridEx was hosted in 2011 and have taken place every other year since.

Law enforcement agencies





GridEx Distributed Play


GridEx is a **Distributed Play** exercise. The E-ISAC's GridEx Planning Team develops core exercise materials, which local Planners across North America use to design and conduct their own exercises for their organizations.

GridEx VII (right) had participants in four countries.





Overlapping Exercises



Distributed Play exercises happen using different instances of the GridEx scenario across North America.

Participants coordinate with others in their region to simulate a real-world emergency.

GridEx VII Findings

GridEx VII Distributed Play Observations and Recommendations

- Non-federal government partners and electric utilities should advance coordination efforts
- Communications and response in a hybrid work environment should be further refined
- Response planning should be augmented to ensure comprehension of technical information across functional teams and external response partners
- The E-ISAC should continue to evolve its support for planners from organizations of varying sizes and with different levels of experience
- Cyber and technical components of the GridEx scenario should continue to be developed and expanded for future iterations of GridEx



After registration, expect an email within two business days from a hagertyconsulting.com domain name with a link to a Microsoft SharePoint Site.



The GridEx VIII Planning Team will share more information about ATSsim Media during the April GridEx training webinar.



New Participation Options


